All members of the team are intricately involved in developing tailored interventions, monitoring patient progress, and developing treatment and discharge plans.

Approach

WCS Integrated Care Wellness Center modality includes strength-based programming focused on autonomy and self-determination. We offer comprehensive assessments to identify key components and individualized needs of those suffering from mental health and behavioral health issues. The WCS team will foster change which can be sustained preventing relapses that would require higher levels of care.

Psychiatric Services

Schedule an appointment with an Advanced Practice Nurse or Psychiatrist within one week of referral to evaluate the effectiveness of current medications and need for medications.

Nurse Navigation

You can expect face-to-face visits one time per week for the first thirty days during which individualized case coordination will be established including Intensive Case Management Services and Support Services.

Primary Care

Individuals not currently linked with a Primary Care Physician (PCP) will be connected with one within one week of referral and will be supported by the Nurse Navigator to ensure they keep the appointment.
